Governor's 21st Century Tax Reform Commission seeks public input

Saint Paul – It just became easier for busy financial, business and development professionals to forward their ideas to The Governor's 21st Century Tax Reform Commission.

The commission is now accepting input by email at taxreform.feedback@state.mn.us. Public testimony is also welcome at all meetings of the commission, which will deliver its final report and revenue-neutral recommendations to Gov. Tim Pawlenty by Dec. 1.

Gov. Pawlenty established the commission to examine how Minnesota's tax code can be improved and modernized to foster new jobs and encourage economic growth in a fast-changing, highly competitive and increasingly global economy.
